

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE REGISTERING

REGISTRATIONS CLOSE on 31 August 2009.

Softball and baseball players are not covered by medical insurance which means that in the event of a personal injury, the player is liable for their own medical costs. The Club recommends that players have their own private health cover.

The use of a well fitted mouth guard for all batters and in-field players is highly recommended.

The club will provide all playing equipment and player's team shirts for use during the current season but these are to be handed back in good condition at the end of the season. Players will need to provide their own black pants, black socks, club cap, mouthguard, players glove (mitt) and protective cup (for the males).

FEES:

Fees can now be paid by direct credit to the club's bank account - see below for details.

Discounts are offered where the player's fees **are paid in full BEFORE their first game** of the season. A non-refundable registration fee of \$20 per player is to be paid when the player is registered. The following fees include the \$20 per player registration fee.

Senior Softball \$130.00 if fees are paid in full BEFORE first game of season
 \$160.00 if fees are paid on or after the first game of the season.
